"For this collection, I used a new performance fabric as a canvas to print five of my signature patterns with a refreshed and vibrant color palette ranging from soft yellows and muted greens, to bold pinks and vivid blues," said Serena Dugan, artist/textile designer. B / TUUCI's patent-pending Equinox Cabana with automated louvered roof features durable, aluminum louvers that automatically adjust for wind and rain to provide shelter while creating an open-air room. The louvers are also operable via remote control. "This provides a new horizon of shade capabilities, born from our seaside and marine-architectural roots," said Dougan Clarke, founder/chief shade architect, TUUCI. "Our cabana design and exterior space philosophy is simply to complement the comfort of raw, beautiful and exposed natural environments." C / Cerno's Calx outdoor sconce "is an existing design that we modified to withstand the elements," said Nick Sheridan, designer, Cerno. "The Calx is an example of modern design where the methods and the materials themselves are integral to its very conception, aligning form and function, which creates a synergy that is evident. The fixture ultimately forms a square aperture but enjoys a beautifully simple faceted structure.' D / Designed by globally renowned architect/ designer Ramón Esteve of Ramón Esteve Studio for Danao, the Hudson Collection is inspired by mid-century modern design and his love for New York. The collection consists of 13 pieces from lounge seating to dining sets. "The Hudson armchair is inspired by the look of classic mid-century modern armchairs, with details like faux leather armrests and a low, reclined sitting position as direct references to this type of chair," Esteve said.
