The patio-friendly design reinterprets the arched stem and floating diffuser of Marc Sadler's 2006 Twiggy lighting family by translating the fiberglass-composite shade into a basket-weave grid. Integrated LEDs cast both direct and indirect light from the end of Twiggy's fishing rodinspired stem, which is rooted to the floor by a disc.
